Dear Mr. Alegría,

In reference to the recent NEAC review of the Placencia Marina submitted by BET on behalf of Placencia Marina Limited and the NEAC's concerns expressed at the meeting, the developer is requesting your kind consideration of the following:

- a. Marina Site Specific Oceanographic Data (wind speed, wave height, sea current and sediment loading): Instead of the requested 2 months period for data collection, the Developer is requesting that this condition be included in the ECP and proposes a data collection period of 5 consecutive years. The results of the study would be submitted on a yearly basis to the Department of the Environment. This data could then be useful in the calibration of the GENESIS Model or other shoreline change prediction model for the Placencia Area.

Methodology: The methodology and the CV of the individuals proposed to conduct and collect data will be submitted to DOE for prior vetting.

- b. Marina Site Bathymetric Map: BET has made arrangement for the process in the bathymetric data collected for the site and will be using



ARC - GIS to generate the site bathymetric map. This will be provided on the 28th January 2010.

- c. GEO Tube Fill Material: BET has initiated the process in classifying the GEO Tube fill material to be used.
- d. Pump Test/Aquifer Test: The developer is requesting that you consider this test to be conducted as part of the ECP with the results to be provided within a two weeks period since this well has already been in production for more than five years.
- e. Marina Entrance: The architects and engineers have been notified of the restrictive entrance to large yachts and adjustments will be made to the design.
- f. Social Benefits: After further review of project collateral business the developer feels that the total amount of Belizean full time employees will be increase to a total of 60 persons.
