Dear Mr. Gordon:

PCSD is making this format complaint about substantive, and what it believes is, wanton disregard for the conditions of the Environmental Compliance Plan for Rendezvous Caye.

The ECP for this development clearly states in Section 1.0 that a buried seawall of approximately 3,000 feet is allowed. Section 3.02.4 of the ECP states that the seawall must be buried to improve the aesthetics of the shoreline.

However, the seawall constructed by the developer is clearly visible above the surface of the sea by approximately 2 feet.

According to Section 4.09 of the ECP, wanton disregard for the conditions agreed upon in [the ECP] may result in the revocation of all permits and licenses issued for the implementation of this project and in the imposition of administrative and/or legal penalties.
